SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING A BROADER RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE AND THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to 1 2 cultivate meaningful relationships with countries and 3 governments to collaborate on solutions to shared challenges; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, the State and the Kingdom of Norway share common 6 challenges as geographically distinct regions with unique 7 environmental, economic, and social concerns; and 8 9 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are deeply reliant on 10 11 their marine environments, with significant portions of their economies and cultures tied to fisheries, aquaculture, and ocean 12 conservation; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Norway has developed one of the world's most 15 sustainable and technologically advanced fishing and aquaculture 16 industries, offering valuable insights that could benefit 17 Hawaii's ongoing efforts to enhance its local seafood production 18 and marine resource management; and 19 20 WHEREAS, both the State and Norway are at the forefront of 21 22 renewable energy development, with Hawaii committed to achieving one hundred percent renewable energy by 2045 and Norway being a 23 global leader in hydropower, offshore wind energy, and electric 24 25 transportation; and 26 WHEREAS, the State could benefit from Norway's expertise in 27 28 electric mobility, sustainable urban planning, and green energy infrastructure, particularly in relation to integrating clean 29 energy into island-based economies; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, tourism is a major economic driver for both Hawaii and Norway, and the two regions can exchange best practices in 33

sustainable tourism management to balance economic growth with 1 environmental preservation; and 2 3 WHEREAS, Norway has a strong tradition of Arctic and marine 4 research that aligns with the State's research institutions' 5 6 focus on oceanography, climate change, and marine biodiversity, creating opportunities for academic and scientific 7 8 collaboration; and 9 WHEREAS, Norway has established a robust social safety net 10 that provides comprehensive healthcare, education, and social 11 welfare programs, serving as a model for policies that support 12 quality of life and economic stability; and 13 14 WHEREAS, fostering a broader relationship between Hawaii 15 and Norway would enhance cross-cultural understanding, 16 facilitate economic and academic partnerships, and promote joint 17 initiatives in renewable energy, ocean conservation, and 18 sustainable development; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 21 22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 23 House of Representatives concurring, that this body supports and encourages a broader relationship between the State and the 24 25 Kingdom of Norway; and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism. 29 30 31 Cen 32
