SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE COUNTIES TO SEEK REVENUES FROM ALTERNATIVE SOURCES, INCLUDING TRANSIT-BASED ADVERTISING, BEFORE IMPOSING ANY NEW OR INCREASED MASS TRANSIT FARE.

WHEREAS, additional revenues are needed to address the 2 rising costs of operating and maintaining the counties' mass transit systems; and

WHEREAS, historically, the counties have attempted to meet 6 these needs by adding or increasing rider fares; and

WHEREAS, new and increased fares often place undue financial burdens on mass transit riders, who already face a high cost of living in Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, public transit should be accessible to persons of all income levels, and additional or increased mass transit fares should be a last resort; and

WHEREAS, by adopting transit-based advertising, the counties could charge governmental and nongovernmental entities reasonable market fees for paid advertisements displayed in, or on, mass transit vehicles; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 22 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the House of Representatives concurring, that the counties are urged to seek revenues from alternative sources, including transitbased advertising, before imposing any new or increased mass transit fare; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that counties that adopt transitbased advertising are encouraged to adopt reasonable restrictions on the advertisements' format, size, material, and content; and
