SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING EACH COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE AND DEPLOY EXPLOSION DETECTION TECHNOLOGY TO LOCATE AND RESPOND TO EXPLOSIONS CAUSED BY THE ILLEGAL USE OF FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS.

WHEREAS, Hawaii residents deserve to live in peace and 1 2 security; and 3 WHEREAS, illegal gunfire and the use of illegal fireworks 4 5 causes public safety risks and health hazards, leading to traumatic impacts; and 6 7 WHEREAS, new technologies have been developed that enable 8 9 law enforcement officers to instantly detect and locate the geographic origin of explosions caused by gunfire or illegal 10 11 fireworks; and 12 13 WHEREAS, police departments using these technologies have reported the ability to receive notification of gunshots within 14 15 forty seconds, leading to faster response times; and 16 17 WHEREAS, ShotSpotter is a leading product in this field, with current usage by more than ninety cities nationwide; and 18 19 WHEREAS, ShotSpotter has been shown to increase reporting 20 of gunshots, decrease the time from reporting to police 21 dispatch, decrease victim transport time, and more accurately 22 identify crime scene locations; and 23 24 25 WHEREAS, in Oakland, California, the ShotSpotter technology assisted law enforcement in responding to more than one-hundred 26 gunshot wound victims; and 27 28 WHEREAS, ShotSpotter and similar technology also has 29 potential for law enforcement use in detecting and responding to 30 illegal fireworks; now, therefore, 31
