## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING HAWAII'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO PETITION THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO ADDRESS THE LACK OF PARITY BETWEEN HAWAII AND OTHER STATES AND TERRITORIES PERTAINING TO THE EXPORT OF AGRICULTURAL GOODS.

WHEREAS, Hawaii is the only state in the nation that is 1 2 regulated similarly to United States territories; and 3 WHEREAS, under title 7 Code of Federal Regulations part 4 318, the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States 5 Department of Agriculture may prohibit or restrict the movement 6 in interstate commerce of any plant or plant product from Hawaii 7 and the territories to the continental United States to prevent 8 the introduction of plant pests on the continent; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the Secretary of Agriculture has determined that 11 12 it is necessary to prohibit the interstate movement of cut flowers, fruits, vegetables, and plants from Hawaii to the 13 continental United States unless specifically allowed; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the list of specifically allows fruits and 16 vegetables is very limited; and 17 18 WHEREAS, for the State to add more agricultural commodities 19 to the allowable list, it is required that a petition be 20 submitted to the United States Department of Agriculture; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the petition requires a pest risk analysis be 23 conducted by the United States Department of Agriculture; and 24 25 WHEREAS, a long-standing problem is that Hawaii waits in 26 the same queue as foreign countries seeking to export products 27 into the United States and the foreign countries' petitions are 28 often deemed a higher priority and therefore expedited; and 29 30



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WHEREAS, shipments of fruits and vegetables require 1 quarantine treatment, inspection, and authorization by the 2 United States Department of Agriculture; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture's 5 quarantine requirements for agricultural commodities grown in 6 Hawaii has severely limited the State's exports; and 7 8 WHEREAS, this constraint has seriously impacted Hawaii's 9 agricultural sector as the State's growers must wait years, if 10 not decades, for the United States Department of Agriculture's 11 authorization; now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 14 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 15 House of Representatives concurring, that Hawaii's congressional 16 delegation is requested to petition the United States Department 17 of Agriculture to address the lack of parity between Hawaii and 18 other states and territories pertaining to the export of 19 agricultural goods; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the members of Hawaii's 23 congressional delegation and Chairperson of the Board of 24 Agriculture. 25 26 27 28 OFFERED BY:
