SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES DIVISION OF FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE TO PRIORITIZE THE RESTORATION AND PROTECTION OF ADDITIONAL WETLANDS AND ANCHIALINE POOLS.

WHEREAS, wetlands are a vital part of Hawaii's environment 1 and ecosystem, and the State has an obligation to protect them; 2 3 and 4 WHEREAS, the State's water quality standards and other 5 legal protections that apply to stream systems and "waters of 6 the State" also apply to Hawaii's wetlands; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the County of Maui requires wetlands to be 9 restored and protected beyond what is minimally required by the 10 Clean Water Act, Coastal Zone Management Act, or other federal 11 laws, and requires all discretionary permits issued by the 12 County to comply with this policy; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the protection and restoration of wetlands helps 15 enhance wildfire and drought resistance; reduces the magnitude 16 of floods; and provides valuable habitats for flora, fauna, and 17 endangered species; and 18 19 WHEREAS, wetlands also act as filters for stream, storm, 20 and urban runoff, preventing high levels of sediment from 21 reaching the ocean; and 22 23 WHEREAS, without the natural filters offered by wetlands, 24 coral reefs, aquatic life, and recreational ocean activities 25 would be threatened; and 26 27 WHEREAS, it is financially prudent for the State to prevent 28 the degradation of wetlands, because, once degraded, wetlands 29 30 can be cost-prohibitive to restore and maintain; and

1 2 WHEREAS, without further protections, the State's anchialine pools are also at risk of degradation, threating the 3 4 pools' rare ecosystems and species; now, therefore, 5 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 7 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land 8 and Natural Resources Division of Forestry and Wildlife is urged 9 to prioritize the restoration and protection of additional 10 wetlands in the State; and 11 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Division of Agricultural Resources is also urged to apply the protective policies 14 afforded to wetlands to the State's anchialine pools; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Division is requested to 18 ensure that the protection of wetlands, especially wetlands in Kihei on the Island of Maui, is prioritized over development 19 concerns, where feasible; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chair of the Board 23 of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife 24 Statewide Program Manager, and Division of Forestry and Wildlife 25 Statewide Program Manager for Native Ecosystem Protection and 26 Management. 27 28 29 30 OFFERED BY:
