SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS TO ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE LEGISLATIVE ENGAGEMENT FORUMS TO EDUCATE AND EMPOWER THE NATIVE HAWAIIAN COMMUNITY REGARDING THE LEGISLATIVE PROCESS.

1		REAS, this body finds that the duties of the Office of

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1 WHEREAS, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs has the resources 2 3 and capacity to facilitate educational initiatives that promote greater awareness and participation in the legislative process; 4 5 and 6 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums will provide 7 8 valuable opportunities for Native Hawaiians to learn about bill drafting, testimony submission, committee hearings, and other 9 10 aspects of civic engagement; and 11 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums may be conducted 12 through in-person workshops, virtual seminars, and outreach 13 14 efforts in various communities across the State; now, therefore, 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 16 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 17 House of Representatives concurring, that the Office of Hawaiian 18 Affairs is requested to establish and provide legislative 19 engagement forums to educate and empower the Native Hawaiian 20 community regarding the legislative process; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 23 is encouraged to collaborate with community organizations, 24 educational institutions, and legislative bodies to ensure the 25 accessibility and effectiveness of these forums; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these legislative engagement forums should include educational materials, workshops, and 29 mentorship opportunities that enable Native Hawaiians to 30 effectively navigate the legislative process; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is urged to provide an annual report to the Legislature 34 summarizing the activities, participation, and impact of these 35 forums, as well as recommendations for further improvement; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 38 39 is urged to consider establishing an advisory group composed of Native Hawaiian leaders, educators, and policy experts to guide **40** and enhance the effectiveness of these efforts; and 41 42

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs and Chief Executive Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
