SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE FUNDING AND SUPPORT TO THE UKRAINIAN MILITARY IN ITS DEFENSE OF AGGRESSION FROM RUSSIA.

WHEREAS, Ukraine declared independence from the Soviet 1 Union on August 24, 1991; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the United States and Ukraine have established 4 diplomatic relations since Ukraine's independence from the 5 6 Soviet Union; and 7 WHEREAS, forty-three thousand Ukrainian soldiers have been 8 9 killed and three hundred seventy thousand wounded as the war with Russia hits its third year, according to the British 10 Broadcasting Company; and 11 12 WHEREAS, on February 2025, the United Nations Human Rights 13 Office of the High Commissioner declared that the ongoing 14 conflict has internally displaced 3.7 million people in Ukraine; 15 16 and 17 WHEREAS, the United Nations Human Rights Monitoring Mission 18 in Ukraine has verified 30,457 civilian casualties since 19 20 February 2022, including 10,582 killed and 19,875 injured, with the actual numbers likely to be significantly higher; and 21 22 WHEREAS, forty percent of Ukraine's population remains in 23 need of some form of humanitarian assistance; and 24 25 WHEREAS, recognizing that the current aid provided by the 26 United States to Ukraine has allowed the country to defend 27 itself and launch a counteroffensive to retake territory from 28 Russia, while providing necessary humanitarian relief for 29 Ukraine's population; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives 32 introduced H.R. No. 155 (2025), reaffirming the United States' 33 unwavering support for Ukraine's sovereignty and independence; 34 35 and

2 WHEREAS, the Ukrainian government needs continued 3 assistance as soon as possible to allow it to effectively defend 4 itself against Russia, as well as longer term plans on how it 5 can manage this crisis; now, therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 8 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 9 that the Congress of the United States is urged to continue to 10 provide funding and support to the Ukrainian military in its 11 defense of aggression from Russia; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body affirms support and solidarity with the free and independent people of Ukraine; and 15

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 17 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States, 18 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, President 19 Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, and members of Hawaii's 20 congressional delegation.
