SENATE RESOLUTION

APPLYING TO THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO CALL AN ARTICLE V CONVENTION TO PROPOSE CERTAIN LIMITED AMENDMENTS TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.

1 WHEREAS, executive orders by the President of the United States have become vehicles for overstepping the President's 2 3 constitutional authority; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the concentration of power at the federal level has made federal officials less responsive to the will of the 6 7 people and more readily influenced by lobbyists, wealthy corporations, and special interest groups; and 8 9 WHEREAS, rulemaking authority allows federal law to be 10 11 enacted by bureaucrats who were never chosen by, and have no accountability to, the people; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing 14 15 national debt through improper and imprudent spending; and 16 17 WHEREAS, policy decisions made at the state level may be more responsive to the people's needs; and 18 19 WHEREAS, federal moneys allocated to Hawaii for economic 20 21 development are generally subject to federal fiscal restraints; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, the federal government has interfered in matters within the states' authority by imposing federal mandates, 25 including unfunded mandates; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, the states can restore the responsiveness of the 29 federal government to the people and restrain federal abuses of power by applying for a convention in accordance with Article V 30 of the United States Constitution to propose amendments to the 31 32 Constitution; now, therefore, 33 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 34 35 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025,

Constitut	ion, limited to amendments that:
(1)	Impose fiscal restraints on the federal government;
(2)	Limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal
	government; and
(3)	Limit the terms of office for federal officials and members of Congress; and
 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application for an Article V convention is subject to the following conditions: 	
(1)	This application to the United States Congress to call
	an Article V convention to propose amendments to the
	United States Constitution confers no power on Congress other than the power to call the convention.
	The power of Congress to exercise this ministerial
	duty consists solely of the authority to name a
	reasonable time and place for the initial meeting of
	the convention;
(2)	Congress shall nonform its ministerial duty of calling
(2)	Congress shall perform its ministerial duty of calling an Article V convention to propose amendments to the
	United States Constitution only upon the receipt of
	applications from two-thirds of the legislatures of
	the several states;
(3)	Congress shall not have the power or authority to
	determine any rules governing an Article V convention.
	Congress shall not have the power to determine the
	number of delegates sent by any state to the convention, or the power to name states' delegates to
	the convention. The power to name delegates remains
	exclusively within the state legislatures;
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At any Article V convention to propose amendments to 1 (4) 2 the United States Constitution, the states shall vote on the basis of one state, one vote; 3 4 A convention of the states convened pursuant to this (5) 5 application shall be limited to the consideration of 6 the topics specified herein, and no others. This 7 application is made with the express understanding 8 9 that no proposed amendment that in any way seeks to amend, modify, or repeal any provision of the Bill of 10 Rights shall be authorized for consideration at any 11 stage of the convention. This application shall be 12 void ab initio if ever used, at any stage, to consider 13 any changes to any provision of the Bill of Rights; 14 15 (6) Pursuant to Article V of the United States 16 Constitution, Congress may determine whether proposed 17 amendments shall be ratified by the legislatures of 18 the several states or by special state ratification 19 conventions. The Legislature of the State of Hawaii 20 recommends that Congress select ratification by the 21 legislatures of the several states; and 22 23 If a convention of the states is convened pursuant to (7) 24 this application, the Legislature of the State of 25 Hawaii reserves the right to provide further 26 instructions to its delegates and to recall its 27 delegates at any time for any breach of duty or 28 violation of the instructions provided; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application constitutes a 31 continuing application in accordance with Article V of the 32 United States Constitution, until the legislatures of at least 33 two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the 34 35 same subject; and 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 37 38 Resolution be transmitted to the Majority Leader and Secretary of the United States Senate, Speaker and Clerk of the United 39 States House of Representatives, members of Hawaii's 40
