SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE HEALTH PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING FOR ALL CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATIONS FOR ANY PROPOSED SPECIAL TREATMENT FACILITY IN NEIGHBORHOODS WITH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

WHEREAS, a certificate of need is an authorization issued 1 by the State Health Planning and Development Agency, which is 2 administratively attached to the Department of Health, to 3 construct, expand, alter, or convert certain health care 4 facilities or to initiate, expand, develop, or modify certain 5 health care services; and 6 7 WHEREAS, an application for a certificate of need generally 8 goes through an administrative review or standard review 9 process; and 10 11 WHEREAS, a certificate of need application may be subject 12 to the administrative review process if the application meets 13 certain criteria, including but not limited to: 14 15 (1)Bed or service changes that have a capital expense of 16 \$1,000,000 or less, and have an increased annual 17 operating expense of less than \$500,000; 18 19 An acquisition of a health care facility or service 20 (2) which will result in a lower annual operating expense; 21 22 and 23 Any proposal that will not have a significant impact (3) 24 25 on the health care system; and 26 WHEREAS, certificate of need applications that do not fall 27 under the administrative review process, emergency situations, 28 or unusual circumstances, will be subject to the standard review 29 process; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the standard review process requires at least one 32 public meeting, during which any person may present written or 33 2025-1756 SR SMA.docx



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oral arguments and evidence relevant to the application and any 1 person directly affected by the application may conduct 2 3 reasonable questioning of persons who make factual allegations relevant to the application; and 4 5 WHEREAS, unlike the standard review process, the 6 administrative review process does not require a public meeting 7 for the application, unless the State Health Planning and 8 9 Development Agency receives a written request from interested 10 persons; and 11 WHEREAS, certificate of need applications for certain 12 special treatment facilities have been approved without a public 13 14 meeting; and 15 WHEREAS, uninformed neighbors, community associations, and 16 area neighborhood boards have expressed frustration at the 17 inability to offer public input on certain special treatment 18 facilities in their neighborhoods applying for a certificate of 19 need; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, pursuant to Hawaii's Sunshine Law, it is the : policy of the State that the formation and conduct of public 23 policy, including the discussions, deliberations, decisions, and 24 action of government agencies, shall be conducted as openly as 25 possible; now, therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 28 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 29 30 that the State Health Planning and Development Agency and Department of Health are requested to hold a public meeting for 31 all certificate of need applications for any proposed special 32 33 treatment facility in neighborhoods with community associations; 34 and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in addition to the current statutory requirements to obtain a certificate of need, the 37 State Health Planning and Development Agency is requested to 38 adopt rules to require certificate of need applicants to appear 39 before the neighborhood board for the area where a proposed 40 41 special treatment facility is located as part of the application process; and 42
