SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONVENE A COMMUNITY NOISE WORKING GROUP TO DISCUSS POLICIES AND LEGISLATION WITH RESPECT TO NOISE SOURCES AFFECTING THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, noise pollution is a public health hazard that continues to negatively affect residents of the State; and

WHEREAS, the most common health problems caused by noise pollution are noise-induced hearing loss, high blood pressure, heart disease, sleep disturbances, and stress; and

WHEREAS, concerts or events held at private venues in primarily residential areas cause higher levels of noise pollution that are not typical of those areas; and

WHEREAS, concerts or events held at private venues are not currently subject to permitting requirements; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, that the Department of Health is requested to convene a Community Noise Working Group to discuss policies and legislation with respect to noise sources affecting the community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Working Group is requested to include the following members:

- (1) The Director of Health, or the Director's designee, who is requested to serve as Chair of the Working Group;
- (2) A member of the Senate, to be appointed by the President of the Senate;
