REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM TO ESTABLISH A VETERINARY MEDICINE EXPANSION WORKING GROUP TO EXPLORE THE FEASIBILITY OF DEVELOPING A DOCTOR OF VETERINARY MEDICINE PROGRAM AT WINDWARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

8	increase financial burdens and reduce the likelihood that a			
9	newly licensed veterinarian will return to Hawaii to practice;

12	WHEREAS, Windward Community College's Veterinary Technology			
13	program has a strong foundation in veterinary education,			
14	providing students with hands-on experience and producing			
15	skilled veterinary technicians; and

17	WHEREAS, expanding Windward Community College's existing			
18	Veterinary Technology program to include a Doctor of Veterinary			
19	Medicine pathway would help address the State's veterinary			
20	workforce shortages and support local agriculture, animal			
21	welfare, and biosecurity; and
