WHEREAS, in the 2024-2025 academic year, 152,270 students are enrolled in two-hundred fifty-eight public schools throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Education employs approximately thirteen thousand teachers, librarians, and counselors, in addition to approximately ten thousand educational officers, civil service, and support services personnel; and

WHEREAS, each year, funding for school facility upgrades and maintenance are among the most frequently requested legislative capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, public schools also have a growing need for the replacement and modernization of aging school equipment; and

WHEREAS, the replacement, refurbishment, and modernization of school equipment will ensure the needs of Hawaii's teachers, school staff, and students are fully met now and into the future; and
