SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO ASSESS THE FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING A SENIOR CITIZEN DISCOUNT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE A TWENTY PERCENT DISCOUNT ON CERTAIN GOODS AND SERVICES FOR LOW- TO MODERATE-INCOME ELDERS IN THE STATE.

WHEREAS, many elders in the State struggle with Hawaii's 1 high cost of living; and 2 3 WHEREAS, elders who age at home pay an average of \$4,814 4 per month for home healthcare costs, in addition to other 5 expenses such as housing, utilities, and food; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the financial burden on elders can lead to 8 increased stress, reduced quality of life, and difficulty in 9 affording essential needs; and 10 11 WHEREAS, in 2010, the Philippines implemented a senior 12 citizen discount program under Republic Act 9994, also known as 13 the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010, to alleviate the 14 financial strain on elders by providing a twenty percent 15 discount on food, housing, utility services, and other goods and 16 services; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, implementing a similar discount program in Hawaii would provide significant financial relief to the State's 20 elderly residents, ensuring that they can afford basic 21 necessities while maintaining their independence and dignity; 22 23 and 24 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services is well-25 positioned to assess the feasibility of such a program and 26 determine its potential benefits and implementation challenges; 27 now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 30 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 31 that the Department of Human Services is requested to conduct a 32 study to assess the feasibility of offering a twenty percent 33



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discount for all low- and moderate-income residents aged sixty-1 2 five and older on expenditures for: 3 4 (1)Housing, including subsidized rent or public housing; 5 (2) Utilities; 6 7 8 (3) Food; and 9 10 (4) Prescription drugs; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human Services is requested to submit a report of its findings and 13 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 14 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 15 the Regular Session of 2026; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 18 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human Services. 19 20 21 Kurt Texella 22 OFFERED BY:
