SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO END THE PRACTICE OF MANDATING THAT CERTAIN STUDENTS ATTEND A SCHOOL OUTSIDE THEIR SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, overcrowding in schools negatively affects student 1 achievement levels, stress levels, attendance, and 2 concentration; and 3 4 WHEREAS, school overcrowding also has a detrimental effect 5 on teacher morale, and limits the time available for teachers to 6 plan and deliver lessons adequately; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, one approach used to address school overcrowding is multi-tracking, which divides students and faculty into 10 multiple groups who attend school year-round on alternating 11 schedules: and 12 13 WHEREAS, multi-tracked schools have achieved average test 14 scores that are two percent lower than students in traditional 15 schools for national reading, math, and language assessments; 16 17 and 18 WHEREAS, studies have shown that multi-tracking is more 19 expensive over the long-term and can harm community and family 20 cohesion, leading to increased stress and burnout for students, 21 teachers, and families; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the Kapolei complex has experienced school 24 overcrowding and implemented multi-tracking to address it; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the overcrowding in the Kapolei complex is 27 partially caused by the mandatory reassignment of students who 28 would otherwise attend a school in the Nanakuli complex; and 29 30 WHEREAS, assigning students to schools in their home 31 complex, Nanakuli, would help balance the distribution of 32 students among the complex areas within the Leeward District and 33 ease overcrowding in the Kapolei complex without the need to 34 multi-track; now, therefore, 35

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1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 2 3 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, that the Department of Education is requested to end the 4 5 practice of mandating that certain students attend a school outside their service area; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 9 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Education and Superintendent of Education. 10 11 12 13
