## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT A GAME MANAGEMENT PLAN THAT INCORPORATES ETHICAL MEANS OF GAME POPULATION CONTROL INTO SUSTAINABILITY STRATEGIES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides 1 direction to the Department of Land and Natural Resources to 2 administer a sustainable hunting program and to promote public 3 hunting; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Act 315, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, amends 6 Chapter 183D, HRS, to clarify that game mammals and birds 7 provide sustainable food sources and merit high-quality habitats 8 having sufficient food, water, and refuge to support viable 9 populations sufficient for hunting; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Act 315 further recognizes that proper management 12 of game populations in appropriate areas benefits watershed 13 areas by minimizing negative impacts of those game populations; 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, in its report to the 2024 Legislature in response 17 to Act 315, the Department described its progress in 18 incorporating local hunting and fishing industries in its food 19 security and sustainability strategies; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the report identified opportunities for hunters to 22 take game and achieve success in the use of hunting to control 23 game populations and offset negative impacts to ecosystems; and 24 25 WHEREAS, concerns remain that the Department may continue 26 to employ unethical means of game population control rather than 27 rely exclusively on hunting and other humane means to prevent 28 overpopulation that negatively impacts sensitive watershed 29 areas; now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 32 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 33 that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is urged to 34 adopt a game management plan that incorporates ethical means of 35
