## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE COUNTY OF MAUI AND THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO PRIORITIZE AND EXPEDITE THE PLANNING, FUNDING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PERMANENT REPLACEMENT FOR THE KULANIHAKOI BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, the Kulanihakoi Bridge, located in South Maui, 1 2 serves as a critical infrastructure component, facilitating 3 transportation and connectivity for residents and visitors 4 alike; and 5 WHEREAS, the Kulanihakoi Bridge was first constructed in 6 1911 and consisted of four individual reinforced concrete box 7 culverts, which were paved in the 1930's, making the foundation 8 9 of the bridge one hundred fourteen years old; and 10 WHEREAS, in 2018, plans were initiated to replace the 11 deteriorating box culverts at the Kulanihakoi River Gulch with a 12 raised bridge to improve safety and resilience; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, the initial project faced significant challenges, including the revelation that proposed temporary road crossings 16 mauka of the South Kihei Road were not permissible under 17 existing flood development regulations, leading to project 18 delays and the need for redesign; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, community organizations, such as the Kihei Community Association, have long advocated for a more 22 cost-effective and improved solution to replace the deteriorated 23 box culverts in the Kulanihakoi River Gulch with a raised 24 bridge, eliminating the need for temporary structures in the 25 riverbed; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the current temporary construction solution at the 28 Kulanihakoi Bridge may not provide the necessary long-term 29 reliability and safety required for the region's infrastructure 30 needs; and 31

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WHEREAS, a permanent replacement of the Kulanihakoi Bridge 1 would enhance transportation safety, improve flood management, 2 and support the economic vitality of South Maui; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, collaboration between the County of Maui and the United States Army Corps of Engineers is essential to design and 6 implement a permanent bridge solution that meets federal, state, 7 and local standards; now, therefore, 8 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 10 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 11 that the County of Maui and the United States Army Corps of 12 13 Engineers are urged to prioritize and expedite the planning, funding, and construction of a permanent replacement for the 14 Kulanihakoi Bridge; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body urges the County of 17 Maui and the United States Army Corps of Engineers to engage 18 with local communities, stakeholders, and experts to ensure the 19 new bridge design addresses environmental concerns, cultural 20 significance, and community needs; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 23 24 Resolution be transmitted to the Commander of the United States Army Corps of Engineers Pacific Ocean Division, Director of 25 Transportation, Mayor of the County of Maui, and Chairperson of 26 the Maui County Council. 27 28 29 30 OFFERED BY:
