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1 greater awareness and participation in the legislative process; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums will provide valuable opportunities for Native Hawaiians to learn about bill 5 drafting, testimony submission, committee hearings, and other 6 7 aspects of civic engagement; and 8 9 WHEREAS, legislative engagement forums may be conducted through in-person workshops, virtual seminars, and outreach 10 efforts in various communities across the State; now, therefore, 11 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, 14 that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is requested to establish 15 and provide legislative engagement forums to educate and empower 16 17 the Native Hawaiian community regarding the legislative process; and 18 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is encouraged to collaborate with community organizations, 21 educational institutions, and legislative bodies to ensure the 22 23 accessibility and effectiveness of these forums; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these legislative engagement 25 forums should include educational materials, workshops, and 26 mentorship opportunities that enable Native Hawaiians to 27 28 effectively navigate the legislative process; and 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 30 is urged to provide an annual report to the Legislature 31 summarizing the activities, participation, and impact of these 32 forums, as well as recommendations for further improvement; and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs 35 is urged to consider establishing an advisory group composed of 36 37 Native Hawaiian leaders, educators, and policy experts to guide and enhance the effectiveness of these efforts; and 38 39 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 41
