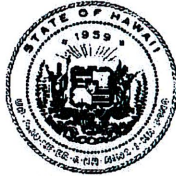

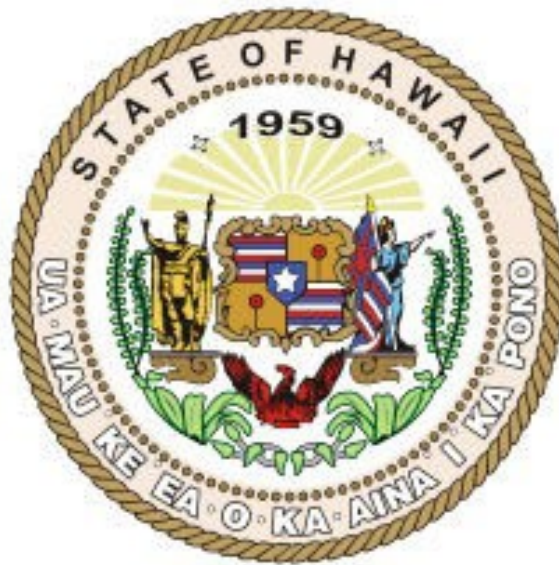

State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna

Act 98, Session Laws of Hawai'i 2023

Act 98, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023 establishes the State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna, which (1) Establishes the State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna, which temporarily expands the State Rent Supplement Program to provide state rent supplement assistance and other services to qualified persons who are sixty-two years of age or older and are homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless; (2) Requires the Hawaii Public Housing Authority to submit annual reports to the Legislature regarding State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna; and (3) Appropriates funds for the State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna; provided that the appropriated funds shall be in addition to the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's base budget.

The Hawaii Public Housing Authority contracted with Catholic Charities Hawaii to administer the State Rent Supplement Program for Kupuna on March 1, 2024. For Fiscal Year 2025, there were 167 Kupuna households enrolled in the program, with an average rent supplement amount of \$398 per Kupuna household, with approximately \$267,968.21 distributed to landlords.
