# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the statewide  
2 parking program for persons with disabilities provides  
3 individuals with mobility disabilities the ability to travel and  
4 park in accessible parking spaces. However, individuals with a  
5 removeable windshield placard that travel to another island or  
6 outside the State are often in situations where they need to  
7 park in an accessible parking space at a Hawaii airport or port  
8 but also must take their windshield placard to be used during  
9 their travels.

10           Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to allow a person  
11 with a removable windshield placard or disabled paid parking  
12 exemption permit but does not have a valid special license  
13 plate, to be issued a disability travel placard that is valid  
14 for a limited period to allow use of the removable windshield  
15 placard when traveling.



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§291- Issuance of a disability travel placard. (a)

5 The issuing agency shall issue one disability travel placard to  
6 an applicant who has a valid removeable windshield placard or  
7 disabled paid parking exemption permit but does not have a valid  
8 special license plate, and presents a completed form, as  
9 provided by the issuing agency, along with a copy of the  
10 applicant's proof of travel.

11 (b) The disability travel placard shall expire on the last  
12 day of the month following the return date indicated on the  
13 proof of travel.

14 (c) For the purposes of this section, "disability travel  
15 placard" means a two-sided, hanger-style placard issued to a  
16 person with a disability who has a valid removable windshield  
17 placard or disabled paid parking exemption permit but does not  
18 have a valid special license plate, and who presents proof of  
19 intrastate or out-of-state travel to the issuing agency."

20 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.




