
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL PARK LEASES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 166-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, if any
- 4 lessee holds a lease having a remaining term of fifteen years or
- 5 less, the department may extend the term of the lease for an
- 6 additional thirty years; provided that the land covered by the
- 7 lease is [÷
- 8 (1) ~~Twenty-five]~~ twenty-five acres or less[; and
- 9 (2) ~~Located in a county having a population of less than~~
- 10 ~~five hundred thousand]~~ ."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Description:

Repeals the requirement for land covered by an agricultural park lease with a remaining term of fifteen years or less to be located in a county having a population of less than five hundred thousand in order for the Department of Agriculture and Biosecurity to extend the lease. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
