
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$5,400,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 first representative district, as follows:

7 1. Moanalua elementary school
8 Construction for a multipurpose
9 innovation center phase 2.
10 Construction \$2,900,000
11 Total funding \$2,900,000

12 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
13 shall be expended by the department of education.

14 2. Salt Lake elementary school
15 Plans, land, design, construction, and
16 equipment and appurtenances for a



1 covered basketball court with security
2 fencing.

9 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
10 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 Plans, design, construction, and
13 equipment and appurtenances for the
14 installation of a jumbotron score board
15 for the athletic stadium.

17	Design	\$20,000
18	Construction	\$120,000
19	Equipment	\$340,000
20	Total funding	\$500,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 4. Moanalua high school

4 Design, construction, and equipment and
5 appurtenances for the replacement of
6 central air conditioning equipment and
7 related infrastructure.

8	Design	\$250,000
9	Construction	\$1,000,000
10	Equipment	\$500,000
11	Total funding	\$1,750,000

12 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
13 shall be expended by the department of education.

14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
17 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
18 of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
