

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 45, Session Laws
3 of Hawaii 2018, codified as section 149A-26, Hawaii Revised
4 Statutes, requires all users of restricted use pesticides to
5 report annually on their use of restricted use pesticides to the
6 department of agriculture and biosecurity.

7 The legislature further finds that to implement this
8 program, the department should provide users with the most
9 efficient and consistent way to report their information. Thus,
10 all users should be able to report their information and data
11 online to the department.

12 The purpose of this part is to require and appropriate
13 funds for the department of agriculture and biosecurity to
14 develop an online restricted use pesticide reporting system
15 through which users may report their restricted use pesticide
16 use directly to the department.



1 SECTION 2. The department of agriculture and biosecurity
2 shall develop an online reporting tool for restricted use
3 pesticide reporting pursuant to section 149A-26, Hawaii Revised
4 Statutes.

5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for
8 the department of agriculture and biosecurity to develop an
9 online reporting tool for restricted use pesticide reporting.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11 agriculture and biosecurity for the purposes of this part.

12 PART II

13 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 to
16 convert full-time equivalent (FTE) temporary
17 environmental health specialist III positions (position numbers
18 123035 and 123036) into full-time equivalent (FTE)
19 permanent environmental health specialist III positions.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 agriculture and biosecurity for the purposes of this part.


