
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FERAL CHICKENS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 142-93.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§142-93.5[+] Mongoose; feral chickens; killing
4 allowed. (a) No person shall be prohibited from killing a
5 mongoose or a feral chicken in any manner not prohibited by law,
6 including by trapping.

7 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to:

8 (1) Permit animal fighting or cockfighting; or
9 (2) Permit the use of torture, starvation, immolation, or
10 beating.

11 (c) As used in the section "feral chicken" means a chicken
12 that is living in a wild and unconfined state."

13 SECTION 2. Section 183D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended by amending the definition of "wild birds" to read as
15 follows:

16 ""Wild birds" means birds, other than game birds, living in
17 a wild and undomesticated state, and the young and eggs of those



1 birds. "Wild birds" does not include feral chickens as defined
2 in section 142-93.5."

3 SECTION 3. Section 711-1109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

5 "(1) A person commits the offense of cruelty to animals in
6 the second degree if the person intentionally, knowingly, or
7 recklessly:

8 (a) Overdrives, overloads, tortures, torments, beats,
9 causes substantial bodily injury to, or starves any
10 animal, or causes the overdriving, overloading,

11 torture, torment, beating, or starving of any animal;

12 (b) Deprives a pet animal of necessary sustenance or
13 causes that deprivation;

14 (c) Mutilates, poisons, or kills without need any animal
15 other than insects, vermin, or other pests; provided
16 that the handling or extermination of any insect,
17 vermin, or other pest is conducted in accordance with
18 standard and acceptable pest control practices and all
19 applicable laws and regulations; provided further that
20 this paragraph shall not apply to acts performed in
21 accordance with section 142-93.5(a);



- 1 (d) Keeps, uses, or in any way is connected with or
- 2 interested in the management of, or receives money for
- 3 the admission of any person to, any place kept or used
- 4 for the purpose of fighting or baiting any bull, bear,
- 5 cock, or other animal, and includes every person who
- 6 encourages, aids, or assists therein, or who permits
- 7 or suffers any place to be so kept or used;
- 8 (e) Carries or causes to be carried, in or upon any
- 9 vehicle or other conveyance, any animal in a cruel or
- 10 inhumane manner;
- 11 (f) Confines or causes to be confined, in a kennel or
- 12 cage, any pet animal in a cruel or inhumane manner;
- 13 (g) Tethers, fastens, ties, or restrains a dog to a
- 14 doghouse, tree, fence, or any other stationary object,
- 15 or uses a trolley, trolley with swivels, pulley,
- 16 cable, running line, or trolley lacking swivels at
- 17 each end that is designed to attach a dog to two
- 18 stationary objects in a configuration that endangers
- 19 the dog, including preventing the dog from obtaining
- 20 necessary sustenance;





9 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11 begun before its effective date.

12 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
