
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$5,790,500 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 second representative district, as follows:

7 1. Moanalua High School, Oahu
8 Design, construction, and equipment and
9 appurtenances for replacement of central
10 air system for student center, building
11 T, which currently has no open windows
12 or other source of ventilation.

15	Equipment	\$500,000

15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2029, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
