
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 45, Session Laws of Hawaii 2024, is amended
by amending section 4 to read as follows:

"SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
and shall apply to bond proceeds expended by a county after
December 31, 2023[, and shall be repealed on June 30, 2028,
provided that section 46-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be
reenacted in the form in which it read on the day before the
effective date of this Act.]; provided that the amendments made
to section 46-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, by section 2 of
this Act shall not be repealed when that section is reenacted
on:

(1) July 1, 2030, pursuant to:

(A) Section 3 of Act 141, Session Laws of Hawaii
2009, as amended by section 3 of Act 102, Session
Laws of Hawaii 2015, as amended by section 1 of
Act 80, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, as amended
