
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT HOMELESSNESS SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The state auditor, in collaboration with
2 the office of the city auditor for the city and county of
3 Honolulu, shall conduct a financial audit of all state and city
4 and county of Honolulu expenditures on programs addressing
5 homelessness within the city and county of Honolulu during the
6 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 fiscal years.

7 (b) The state auditor and office of the city auditor shall
8 coordinate data collection, methodology, and reporting.

9 (c) The audit shall include:

10 (1) Total expenditures by program and agency;

11 (2) Program outcomes, to the extent data is available;

12 (3) The number of homeless individuals served by each
13 program; and

14 (4) Calculations of total spending per homeless individual
15 served.

16 (d) The state auditor and office of the city auditor shall
17 submit a single consolidated report of their findings and



1 recommendations to the legislature no later than twenty days
2 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2027.


3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 for the
6 audit of homelessness program expenditures required by this Act.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the city and
8 county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
