
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$293,050,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 second representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kapolei high school, Oahu

8 A. Construction of a new performing arts
9 auditorium to promote arts education
10 and meet the needs of west side
11 schools, which currently have no
12 auditoriums.

9 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
11 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
12 second representative district, as follows:

13 1. Kanehili Hawaiian Homestead, Oahu
14 Construction of Kanehili Community
15 Association Park.
16 Total funding \$1,500,000
17 2. Kaupe'a Hawaiian Homestead, Oahu
18 A. Construction of Kaupe'a Hawaiian
19 Homestead Community Park.
20 Total funding \$2,000,000



1 B. Completion of a retaining wall along

8 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue
9 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
12 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
13 second representative district, as follows:

14 1. Kapolei Parkway, Oahu

15 Construction of crosswalks, speed
16 humps/speed tables, and road signs on
17 Kapolei Parkway due to its proximity to
18 Kapolei high school and Kapolei middle
19 school.

20 Total funding: \$2,000,000



1 SECTION 4. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$10,000,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 second representative district, as follows:

7 1. Villages of Kapolei Association, Oahu

8 Construction, equipment and
9 appurtenances for maintenance and
10 upkeep of roads, vegetation, and road
11 upgrades.

13 SECTION 5. The appropriation made for the capital
14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
16 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2029, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective
19 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
20 department of education for the purposes of this Act.




1 SECTION 7. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
3 department of Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 8. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital projects set forth in section 3 shall be expended by the
6 department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 9. The sums appropriated for the respective
8 capital projects set forth in section 4 shall be expended by the
9 Hawaii housing finance and development corporation for the
10 purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
