## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII FILM AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT  
SPECIAL FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1.   Section 201-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2   amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3       "(a)   There is established in the state treasury the Hawaii  
4   film and creative industries development special fund into which  
5   shall be deposited:

6       (1)   Appropriations by the legislature;

7       (2)   Donations and contributions made by private  
8       individuals or organizations for deposit into the  
9       fund;

10      (3)   Grants provided by governmental agencies or any other  
11      source;

12      (4)   Effective January 2, 2023, all revenues, fees, and  
13      charges from the processing of the motion picture,  
14      digital media, and film production income tax credit  
15      pursuant to section 235-17; and

16      (5)   ~~[Effective July 1, 2022, all existing and future]~~ All  
17      revenues, fees, and income received by the department



JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Business, Economic Development, and Tourism

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII  
FILM AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES DEVELOPMENT  
SPECIAL FUND.

PURPOSE: To allow revenues generated from the  
management of the Hawaii Film Studio to be  
deposited into and expended out of the  
Hawaii Film and Creative Industries  
Development Special Fund.

MEANS: Amend section 201-113(a), Hawaii Revised  
Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: This bill will expand funding resources to  
support a sustainable ecosystem for the  
creative economy's media and entertainment  
sectors, aligning with the strategic vision  
to strengthen workforce and talent  
development, infrastructure development, and  
access to capital in the State.

Impact on the public: The bill would  
provide a foundation for expanding Hawaii's  
creative industries, supporting growth,  
innovation, and new opportunities for the  
public.
