
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 329-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

(1) By amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any of the following opiates, including their isomers, esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters, and ethers, whenever the existence of these isomers, esters, ethers, and salts is possible within the specific chemical designation:

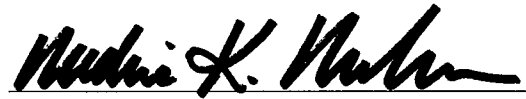

DEPARTMENT: Law Enforcement

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIFORM
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

PURPOSE: To update the Uniform Controlled Substances
Act, chapter 329, Hawaii Revised Statutes
(HRS), to make it consistent with amendments
in the federal controlled substances law.

MEANS: Amend section 329-14(b) and (e), HRS.

JUSTIFICATION: Section 329-11, HRS, requires that the
Department annually recommend changes to
Hawaii law to correspond with changes to the
Federal Controlled Substances Act.

Impact on the public: This bill aims to
protect the public by updating Hawaii's
controlled substance schedules to align with
Federal law.

Impact on the department and other agencies:
These proposed amendments would assist the
Department's Narcotics Enforcement Division
in clarifying regulations of the Uniform
Controlled Substances Act.
