
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$146,000,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fortieth
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. East Kapolei Elementary, Ewa Beach, Oahu
8 Plans, land acquisition, design,
9 construction, equipment, and
10 appurtenances for a new elementary
11 school using standards based designs,
12 modern educational specifications,
13 design guides, construction
14 specifications, standard technical
15 drawings, and commissioning plans, for



1 accelerated construction schedules and
2 building maintainability.

3 Design \$3,972,000
4 Construction \$142,028,000
5 Total funding \$146,000,000

6 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
7 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,080,000 or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
10 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fortieth
11 representative district, as follows:

12 1. Road improvements, Oahu
13 A. Plans and design, supplies,
14 construction, and equipment for audible
15 beaconing signals at Fort Weaver Road
16 and Keaunui Drive traffic light
17 intersections for disabled blind
18 pedestrians.

19 Total funding \$810,000

20 B. Plans and design, supplies,
21 construction, and equipment for audible



1 beaconing signals at Fort Weaver Road
2 and Geiger Road traffic light
3 intersections for disabled blind
4 pedestrians.

5 Total funding \$1,270,000

6 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
9 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2029, shall lapse as of that date.


11 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
12 capital project set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
13 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital project set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
16 department of transportation for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
