
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,150,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
6 first representative district, as follows:

7 1. Ewa Beach Elementary School, Oahu

8 A. Construction, equipment, and
9 appurtenances for repairs and
10 rehabilitation of an existing air
11 conditioning system serving one
12 instructional building.

14 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
15 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$29,000,000 or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
18 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-
19 first representative district, as follows:

20 1. Ewa Beach District Recreation Center, Oahu



1 Plans, design, and construction to
2 convert Ewa Puuloa District Park to a
3 multipurpose recreation center.

4 Plans and design \$2,000,000
5 Construction \$18,000,000
6 Total funding \$20,000,000

7 2. Ewa Beach Sports Complex, Oahu
8 Plans, design, and construction to
9 build a sports complex on the four
10 hundred acres recently turned over from
11 the U.S. Navy to the City and County of
12 Honolulu.

13 Plans and design \$1,000,000
14 Construction \$8,000,000
15 Total funding \$9,000,000

16 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
19 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2029, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital project set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital project set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
6 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
7 this Act.

8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
