
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$80,950,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the eighth
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. Kohala high school

8 Design, construction, and equipment and
9 appurtenances for new gym, ground and
10 site improvements; equipment and
11 appurtenances.

12 Design \$1,000

13 Construction \$36,998,000

14 Equipment \$1,000

15 Total funding \$37,000,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 2. Waimea elementary school

4 Design and construction for site

5 improvements, including parking lot
6 improvements.

7 Design \$500,000

8 Construction \$2,000,000

9 Total funding \$2,500,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 3. Lapakahi state historical park

13 Construction and equipment and
14 appurtenances for restroom fac
15 improvements.

16 Construction \$199,000

18 Total funding \$200,000

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
20 shall be expended by the department of land and natural
21 resources.



1 4. Puakea Bay trail

2 Plans and design for Puakea Bay trail
3 repairs and improvements.

4 Plans \$125,000

5 Design \$25,000

6 Total funding \$150,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the department of land and natural
9 resources.

10 5. Pololū trailhead

11 Design and construction for trailhead
12 improvements, including parking lot
13 improvements, new lookout construction,
14 and interpretive signage design and
15 manufacturing.

16 Design \$1,000

17 Construction \$1,999,000

18 Total funding \$2,000,000

19 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
20 shall be expended by the department of land and natural
21 resources.



1 6. South Kohala district courthouse
2 Design, construction, and equipment and
3 appurtenances for new courthouse
4 facility; ground and site improvements;
5 equipment and appurtenances, and
6 infrastructure, including providing
7 separate waiting areas, accessible
8 restrooms, secure holding areas, and
9 expanded office space to accommodate
10 judicial staff and client services with
11 energy-efficient systems to support
12 sustainable operations.

13	Design	\$1,000
14	Construction	\$29,998,000
15	Equipment	\$1,000
16	Total funding	\$30,000,000

17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
18 shall be expended by the judiciary.

19 7. Waimea emergency shelter
20 Design and construction for an
21 emergency shelter; provided that no



1 funds shall be expended unless matched
2 on a dollar-for-dollar basis by funds
3 from the county of Hawaii.

4 Design \$1,000
5 Construction \$7,499,000
6 Total funding \$7,500,000
7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
8 shall be expended by the Hawaii emergency management agency.

9 8. Waikoloa second access road
10 intersection
11 Plans and design for a new access road
12 intersection with Queen Ka‘ahumanu
13 highway.

14 Plans \$1,000
15 Design \$1,599,000
16 Total funding \$1,600,000
17 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
18 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

19 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
20 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
21 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;




1 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
