
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-801, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
3
4 "(f) The board may employ an executive director for a term
5 of up to four years, who shall be appointed by the board of
6 education, with the advice and consent of the senate, and
7 without regard to chapters 76 and 89; provided that the board of
8 education shall appoint the executive director from a list of
9 three nominees submitted by the board [shall submit a nominee]
10 to the board of education [for approval or disapproval];
11 provided further that if the senate fails to confirm the nominee
12 [is disapproved], the board of education shall submit another
13 nominee to the [board of education] senate for [approval or
14 disapproval.] advice and consent.

15 The board may terminate the executive director's contract
16 for cause; provided that the board shall submit the
17 recommendation for termination to the board of education for
approval or disapproval."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
