
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PARKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Wailuku river
2 state park is an important natural, cultural, and recreational
3 resource that provides public access to open space and
4 opportunities to experience the natural environment. Access to
5 parks and natural areas supports mental and physical health by
6 reducing stress, improving emotional well-being, and encouraging
7 walking, bicycling, and other outdoor activities that promote
8 lifelong wellness.

9 The legislature further finds that public parks serve as
10 essential community gathering places that foster social
11 interaction, cultural connection, and shared stewardship of the
12 land. The expansion of Wailuku river state park will not only
13 enhance its role as a natural, cultural, and recreational
14 resource and opportunity for the public to access open space and
15 the natural environment, but also support the creation of a
16 vehicle-free safe route to school, improving student safety and



1 independence while reducing traffic congestion, allowing parents
2 to get to work on time, and relieving family stresses.

3 The legislature concludes that establishing and funding the
4 expansion of Wailuku river state park will promote mental
5 health, physical well-being, safe mobility, and community
6 connection, while enhancing equitable access to this public
7 resource for present and future generations.

8 The purpose of this Act is to authorize and appropriate
9 funds for the expansion of Wailuku River State Park.

10 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
11 may acquire the fee simple interest in the following parcels for
12 the expansion of Wailuku river state park:

- 13 (1) TMK (3) 2-5-008-003;
- 14 (2) TMK (3) 2-5-008-025;
- 15 (3) TMK (3) 2-5-008-026; and
- 16 (4) TMK (3) 2-5-008-027.

17 SECTION 3. The following sums or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 are appropriated or
19 authorized, as the case may be, from moneys in the treasury
20 received from general obligation bond funds and federal grants
21 to finance the capital improvement project listed below. The



- 1 letter symbols used after the specific project appropriations
2 indicate the source of financing and have the following meaning:
3 (C) general obligation bond fund and (N) federal funds.



13 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated shall be expended, and
14 the bonds authorized shall be issued, by the department of land
15 and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 5. The appropriation made for the capital
17 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

21 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
