
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEASUREMENT STANDARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 486-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3
4 " (a) Unless otherwise provided by law, the department,
5 through the measurement standards branch, shall inspect and
6 test, to ascertain if they are correct, all measurement
7 standards and measuring devices kept, offered, or exposed for
8 sale, sold, or in use in the State. The department may, as
9 often as it deems necessary, inspect and test, to ascertain if
10 they are correct, all measurement standards and measuring
11 devices used in:

12 (1) Determining the measurement of commodities or things
13 sold, or offered or exposed for sale, on the basis of
14 measure;
15 (2) Computing the basic charge or payment, including
16 taxes, for services rendered on the basis of measure;
