
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$21,371,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the fiftieth
representative district, as follows:

1. Aikahi elementary school, Oahu

Construction for repairing walkways.

Construction	\$300,000

The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
shall be expended by the department of education.

2. Kailua high school, Oahu

Construction for football field
improvements.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
7 of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
