
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$36,375,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 seventh representative district, as follows:

7 1. Waiawa correctional facility

8 Design and construction for facility-
9 wide fire sprinkler system improvements
10 and repairs to enhance life safety,
11 ensure compliance with current fire
12 codes, and improve overall system
13 reliability, including all necessary
14 appurtenances.

15 Design \$150,000
16 Construction \$1,350,000



1 Total funding \$1,500,000

2 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
3 shall be expended by the department of corrections and
4 rehabilitation.

5 2. Waiawa correctional facility

6 Design and construction for critical
7 facility wastewater system improvements
8 to resolve ongoing sewage backups,
9 accommodate increased flow capacity,
10 and install modern monitoring systems
11 to enhance operational efficiency and
12 reliability.

13 Design \$400,000

14 Construction \$3,600,000

15 Total funding \$4,000,000

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
17 shall be expended by the department of corrections and
18 rehabilitation.

19 3. Waiawa correctional facility

20 Design and construction for facility-
21 wide electrical distribution system



1 repairs and upgrades to improve
2 reliability, address aging
3 infrastructure, and support current and
4 future operational demands.

9 shall be expended by the department of corrections and

12 Design and construction for facility-
13 wide plumbing system improvements to
14 repair and replace deteriorated piping,
15 address leaks, and improve water
16 efficiency and system reliability.

16 ensure long-term durability.

12 10. Lehua elementary school
13 Design and construction for the
14 expansion and reconfiguration of the
15 student drop-off and pick-up area to
16 address traffic congestion and safety
17 concerns and for perimeter fencing and
18 campus lighting systems to deter
19 unauthorized nighttime access.

21 Construction \$2,750,000

19 14. Pearl City high school

20 Plans and construction for the
21 installation of air conditioning



1 systems in career and technical
2 education classrooms to improve
3 instructional conditions, equipment
4 performance, and student safety.

5 Plans \$300,000

6 Construction \$2,200,000

7 Total funding \$2,500,000

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 15. University of Hawaii West Oahu

11 Construction for a comprehensive campus
12 master facilities maintenance plan to
13 identify deficiencies, prioritize
14 capital needs, and prevent future
15 facilities failures.

16 Construction \$1,000,000

17 Total funding \$1,000,000

18 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
19 shall be expended by the University of Hawaii West Oahu.

20 16. University of Hawaii West Oahu

6 skyline rail station.

16 spaces honoring military service.

18 traffic from the new building J.

9 Plans and construction for pedestrian

13 awareness, and enhance safety f

14 pedestrians, students, transit riders

15 and residents, with improvements

17 areas, and roadway segments with

18 documented speeding and pedestrian

8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
9 shall be expended by the department of transportation.

10 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
11 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
12 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
13 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
14 of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
