A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Moanalua High School

8 A. Replacement of the central air
9 conditioning system for student
10 center, building T.


16 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
3 expended for the purposes of this Act by the department of
4 education.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
