A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 602-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§602-51 How constituted.** The intermediate appellate
4 court shall consist of a chief judge and [~~six~~] seven associate
5 judges. The chief judge, who shall be specifically selected,
6 shall supervise the administrative duties of the court."

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$494,814 or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 to the
10 judiciary for an additional intermediate appellate court
11 associate judge, which shall be allocated as follows:

12 (1) \$231,276 for the establishment of one permanent
13 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) intermediate appellate
14 court associate judge position;
15 (2) \$86,688 for the establishment of one permanent
16 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) judicial assistant
17 position;

1 (3) \$134,400 for the establishment of two permanent
2 full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) law clerk positions;
3 and
4 (4) \$42,450 for equipment, books, and furniture for the
5 new associate judge's chambers.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
7 the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
