A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CULTURAL RECOGNITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§6E- Maunalua island markers. The department shall
5 place historical markers on the landform on which the Hawaii Kai
6 Towne Center is sited to recognize the landform as Maunalua
7 island."

8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
