A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 521-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~[§]521-77~~ **Investigation and resolution of complaints**
4 **by the office of consumer protection.** The office of consumer
5 protection may receive, investigate and attempt to resolve any
6 dispute arising under this chapter~~[§]~~, pursuant to section
7 487-5(6)."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
