## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1        SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under current law, a  
2    person may be prohibited by a lawful judicial protective order  
3    or restraining order from possessing, controlling, or  
4    transferring ownership of a firearm or ammunition. However, a  
5    violation of this prohibition is subject to only a misdemeanor  
6    penalty.

7        The legislature finds that an active court order for  
8    protection or restraining order is an indication of an increased  
9    lethality risk for the protected party and others, and that  
10   unlawful possession, control, or transfer of a firearm or  
11   ammunition under such circumstances is a serious violation of  
12   public safety.

13       The purpose of this Act is to establish a class C felony  
14   penalty for the unlawful possession, control, or transfer of a  
15   firearm or ammunition in violation of a judicial protective  
16   order or restraining order.



1 SECTION 2. Section 134-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (j) to read as follows:

3 " (j) Any person violating subsection (a) ~~(e)~~, (b), or (f)  
4 shall be guilty of a class C felony; provided that any felon  
5 violating subsection (b) shall be guilty of a class B felony and  
6 if said prior felony conviction is that of a crime of violence,  
7 as defined in section 134-1, the defendant shall be sentenced to  
8 an indeterminate term of imprisonment as provided by law. Any  
9 person violating subsection (c), (d), (e), ~~(f)~~, (g), or (h)  
10 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."


11 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
13 begun before its effective date.

14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
