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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the  
2       Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2026.

3       SECTION 2. Act 227, Session Laws of Hawaii 2025, is  
4       amended as follows:

5       1. By amending part II to read:

6                       **"PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

7       SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may  
8       be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated  
9       herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of  
10      funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium  
11      beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The total  
12      expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions  
13      established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not  
14      exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each  
15      year, except as provided in this Act.

appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the projects listed below; provided that several related or similar projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects separately. The amount after each cost element and the total funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of dollars.

## 1                   PART V.   ISSUANCE OF BONDS

2           SECTION 9.   General obligation bonds may be issued, as  
3 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to  
4 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part IV of  
5 this Act; provided that the sum total of the general obligation  
6 bonds so issued shall not exceed [~~\$12,900,000.~~] \$68,300,000."

7           SECTION 3.   If any portion of this Act or its application  
8 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any  
9 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall  
10 not be affected.   If any portion of a specific appropriation is  
11 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall  
12 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to  
13 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the  
14 extent possible.

15          SECTION 4.   If any manifest clerical, typographical, or  
16 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice  
17 may correct the error.   All changes made pursuant to this  
18 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular  
19 session.

20          SECTION 5.   Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
21 and stricken.   New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
