A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 " (e) No driver's license shall be renewed by the examiner
4 of drivers unless:

5 (1) The examiner of drivers is satisfied of the
6 applicant's fitness to continue to operate a motor
7 vehicle;

8 (2) If the applicant has received a traffic citation or
9 infraction within the previous five years from the
10 date that the applicant files for renewal, completes
11 an educational course that includes:

12 (A) An online road safety video developed by the
13 department of transportation; and

14 (B) A written road safety examination that tests an
15 applicant's:

16 (i) Ability to understand highway signs
17 regulating, warning, and directing traffic;





1 [44] (5) The examiner of drivers is satisfied that the
2 applicant does not have outstanding charges and fines
3 relating to the disposition of an abandoned vehicle."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
