A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISPOSABLE BODYBOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that disposable
2 bodyboards are often comprised of polystyrene, also known as
3 Styrofoam. Polystyrene, once discarded, can quickly
4 disintegrate, leaving behind plastic foam that can pollute the
5 State's reefs, shoreline, and marine ecosystems. Recently, the
6 Kauai county council unanimously passed a bill banning the sale,
7 rental, or distribution of these disposable bodyboards to
8 reflect their commitment to maintaining Kauai's unique marine
9 environment. A statewide ban would comprehensively expand this
10 positive environmental policy and support a shift towards
11 durable, reusable options to reduce waste, support responsible
12 tourism, and promote a smaller environmental footprint.

13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to prohibit the
14 sale, rental, or distribution of disposable bodyboards in the
15 State.



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§342D- Sale, rental, and distribution of disposable
5 bodyboards; prohibition. (a) Beginning January 1, , it
6 shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale, rent, or distribute
7 for sale in the State any disposable bodyboard.

8 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be fined:
9 (1) \$100 for a first violation;
10 (2) \$200 for a section violation; and
11 (3) \$500 for each subsequent violation in the same year.

12 Each day of continued violation under this section shall
13 constitute a distinct and separate offense.

14 (c) For the purposes of this section "disposable
15 bodyboard" means a buoyant rectangular object over twenty-three
16 inches in length with a polystyrene foam core used for water
17 recreation."

18 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
19 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
20 begun before its effective date.




1 SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act, or the
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
4 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
6 of this Act are severable.

7 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
