A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LAND TRANSFER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, directed
2 the conveyance to the department of education of the fee simple
3 title to certain lands owned by the department of land and
4 natural resources, county of Kauai, and county of Maui. Since
5 that time, further verification of information and changes in
6 circumstances require the revision of tax map key numbers
7 provided in Act 307.

8 Accordingly, the purposes of this Act are to:

9 (1) Revise certain tax map key numbers set forth in
10 section 2 of Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, for
11 accuracy or changed circumstances; and

12 (2) Revise the process by which properties were, or may in
13 the future be conveyed to the department of education
14 pursuant to Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022.

15 SECTION 2. Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is
16 amended by amending section 2 to read as follows:

17 "SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the
18 contrary, the fee simple interest to the parcels of land set

1 forth in this section, together with the existing improvements
2 thereon, but not including submerged land, accreted land, or any
3 land makai of the legal shoreline (collectively, the
4 properties), shall be conveyed by their respective owner or
5 owners to the department of education as grantee, as is, where
6 is. The department of education shall accept the properties in
7 their existing condition. All claims and liabilities against
8 the grantors, if any, that the department of education has, may
9 have had, or may have in the future, regarding any injury, loss,
10 cost, damage, or liability, including reasonable attorney's
11 fees, concerning the physical, environmental, soil, economic,
12 and legal conditions of the properties, shall be released,
13 waived, and extinguished.

14 (b) The transfer of the properties pursuant to this Act
15 shall be effective by operation of law as of July 1, 2022. The
16 respective owner or owners of the properties shall prepare,
17 execute, and record, in the [~~land court or bureau of~~
18 ~~conveyances,~~] office of the assistant registrar of the land
19 court of the State of Hawaii or the State of Hawaii bureau of
20 conveyances, as appropriate, a quitclaim deed [~~to convey each~~
21 ~~of~~] or other conveyance instrument to evidence and formally
22 document the conveyance of each of the properties together with

1 all existing improvements. ~~[Work to initiate the conveyance of~~
2 ~~the properties shall commence no later than December 31, 2022.~~
3 ~~As an alternative to conveyance instruments for each parcel of~~
4 ~~state or county owned land, the transfer of such lands shall be~~
5 ~~completed by operation of law.]~~ Where applicable and in the
6 discretion of the department of education, the department of
7 education may elect to obtain all or a portion of each parcel
8 identified by this Act. If the department of education elects
9 to obtain a portion or portions of any parcel identified by this
10 Act, then the parties to the conveyance shall take all actions
11 necessary to legally effect the same.

12 (c) As these are conveyances in which the county and the
13 State and its agencies are the only parties, the tax imposed by
14 section 247-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall not apply.

15 (d) Effective ~~[on the date of transfer,]~~ as of July 1,
16 2022, every reference to the titleholder of the properties shall
17 be construed as a reference to the department of education ~~[+]~~
18 irrespective of whether a quitclaim deed or other conveyance
19 document has been recorded in the office of the assistant
20 registrar of the land court of the State of Hawaii or the State
21 bureau of conveyances.

DEPARTMENT: Education

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LAND TRANSFER.

PURPOSE: To revise tax map key numbers in Act 307, Session Laws of Hawaii (SLH) 2022, and the process for conveying the properties in Act 307, SLH 2022.

MEANS: Amend section 2 of Act 307, SLH 2022.

JUSTIFICATION: This bill is an administrative housekeeping bill. The enactment of Act 307, SLH 2022, directed the conveyance of the fee simple title to certain lands owned by the Department of Land and Natural Resources, County of Kauai, and County of Maui to the Department. This bill amends Act 307, SLH 2022, to update the list of properties to be conveyed.

This bill also clarifies the conveyance process to transfer the lands. The bill provides more flexibility by allowing other types of conveyance instruments besides a quitclaim deed to evidence the conveyance by Act 307, SLH 2022. This bill also clarifies that all transfers of the listed properties were effective by operation of law on the date Act 307, SLH 2022, was enacted, on July 1, 2022. The quitclaim deed or other conveyance document to be recorded for each property is a formality that is not necessary for the transfer of the listed properties.

This bill will provide the Department with sole ownership of all land under existing public schools. The Department would have increased flexibility and operational efficiency to redevelop, reposition, and improve its assets in a timely and efficient manner.

Impact on the public: The public wants greater efficiency, faster project completion, and better use of taxpayer money in the development of school facilities. Through authorization of land transfers to the Department, the public will see improved school facilities, which will directly impact the quality of education and student well-being.

Impact on the Department and other agencies: This bill is an administrative housekeeping bill. By directly owning the property, the Department maintains control over its use and development. This policy ensures that land, a fundamental public resource, is perpetually dedicated to the mission of public education.
