A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$81,324,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
senatorial district, as follows:

1. Kihei Library

A. Plans and design to relocate the
library outside the flood zone.

A. Plans for the Kihei bypass from
Maui meadows north of Piilani
highway to Kulanihakoi high
school.

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
12 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
13 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
14 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
17 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
18 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

19 (1) The sum appropriated in item 1 shall be expended by
20 the department of accounting and general services;




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- 1 (2) The sum appropriated in item 2 shall be expended by
2 the department of transportation;
3 (3) The sums appropriated in items 3 through 5 shall be
4 expended by the department of education;
5 (4) The sums appropriated in items 6 through 12 shall be
6 expended by the department of land and natural
7 resources.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
