# A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$69,386,000 or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2026-2027  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh  
senatorial district, as follows:

1. Molokai irrigation system

A. Replacement of corroded couplings  
and underground valves, painting  
of transmission lines, and repair  
of transmission lines near the  
reservoir inlet.

14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
 17 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
 18 unencumbered as of June 30, 2028, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 20 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 21 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:



- 1 (1) The sum appropriated in item 1 shall be expended by  
2 the department of agriculture and biosecurity; and  
3 (2) The sum appropriated in item 2 shall be expended by  
4 the department of transportation.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2026.
