was referred S.B. No. 2627 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND
TOURISM,"

The purpose and intent of this measure is to amend the law
relating to economic development and tourism.

Prior to the hearing on this measure, your Committee posted
and made available for public review a proposed S.D. 1, which
amends this measure by deleting its contents and replacing it with
language that exempts the Hawaii Tourism Authority's contracts or
agreements for sports projects and events and marketing activities
from the Hawaii Public Procurement Code and all other requirements
of law for competitive bidding.


Your Committee has amended this measure by adopting the
