Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 3203, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO AIR MEDICAL SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish the Statewide Air Medical Services Program within the Department of Health's Emergency Medical Services and Injury Prevention Systems Branch to coordinate and strengthen air medical transport services;
- (2) Establish an Air Medical Director, Air Medical Program Manager, and Air Medical Coordinator to administer the program; and
- (3) Require annual air medical ambulance licensure and accreditation fees for air medical providers to be deposited into the Emergency Medical Services Special Fund to cover the costs of the program.
